



Horse Adoption Agreement

This agreement is entered into this day, _____
And shall be effective for the life of the described animal –

Hereinafter known as the horse.

This agreement is between _____
Hereinafter known as the Lesser, and Heavy Horse Heaven Inc, hereinafter known as the
Lessee.

The following terms and conditions shall apply for the length of the horse's natural life.

The Lesser agrees to care for and maintain the horse and shall have exclusive use of the horse
for the purpose of – _____.

The horse shall NOT be used for breeding of any kind unless stated in this agreement.
The Lesser shall use proper care and good judgement in maintaining the horse in as good or
better condition than it was at the commencement of this agreement. The Lesser is
responsible for all expenses incurred in the management of the horse during the term of the
agreement and shall not return the horse because it becomes ill. If the horse requires medical
attention while in care it must be sort and all expenses incurred are the responsibility of the
Lesser. If the Lesser can no longer care for the horse and it is returned to the Lessee while ill
then all cost associated with this illness fall on the Lesser.

The Lessee shall not be held responsible for any loss, damage, injury, claim, demand, cost
and expense (including legal expense) arising out of or connected with the use, stabling or
actions for the horse whether under control and supervision of the Lesser or not during the
term of this agreement. The Lessee will not be responsible for any accident or injury to any
person or animal that comes in contact with the horse, during the term of this agreement.

The Lesser agrees to provide photographic evidence of the horse's wellbeing every 3 months
or more frequently at such times as the Lessee should request in writing which includes by
fax or email.

The Lesser notes that the Lessee may request to see the horse with 48 hours notice in writing
which includes fax or email and if the Lessee is not satisfied with the care and condition of
the horse the Lessee may give notice in writing to remedy the breach. This notice is to clearly
outline the areas in which the Lessee believes the care of the horse to be deficient. Should the
breach not be remedied to the satisfaction of the Lessee the agreement may be terminated and
the stated horse returned to the Lessee. Should the horse be returned to the Lessee such

reasonable costs as are associated with the transport of the horse shall be at the expense of the Lesser.

Should the horse not be returned within 48 hours after the failure to rectify a breach, the Lessee may make arrangements to seize the horse and the Lesser will be liable for all costs associated.

Should the Lesser be unable to keep the horse it is to be returned to the Lessee at the expense of the Lesser and shall not be given away or sold.

The horse will be kept at

If the Lesser moves property and the horse's stabling address changes the Lesser must gain permission from the Lessee in writing including fax or email within 24 hours before the horse is moved. If the horse is moved for extended periods but its stabling address has not changed the Lesser shall notify the Lessee of the whereabouts of the horse.

If the horse passed away or needs to be humanely put to sleep, the Lesser must provide the Lessee with either photographic evidence of the deceased horse or a vet report stating that the horse is now deceased. The horse's description must be present in the vet report including marking, brands and microchip number.

In the event of the death of the Lesser the horse shall be returned to the Lessee for re-homing. In the event of the Lesser closing down the stated contract will revert to another not-for-profit horse rescue of its choice that will become the Lessee.

The horse shall remain the sole property of the Lessee and the Lesser shall have no right, title, or loan to any other party of the said horse.

The Lesser agrees to make a tax deductible donation to the Lessee at the time of leasing for the amount of _____ which is the stated value of the horse.
